For the benefit of members who keep their back copies of the NWPPA Journal, here is an index of all the subjects covered in this series so far, the aim of the articles always having been to provide properly-researched and accurate biographical details of musicians who were important in the player piano era as pianists, composers or both, with four celebrated singers also included for good measure. The first 40 articles were written jointly by my late wife Marguerite and myself, starting in 1979. Three were 'in stock' at the time of Marguerite's sudden death in 1994, and since then I have soldiered on writing them alone. I believe these articles fulfil a need to give an account of the lives of (especially) important player piano recording pianists, providing thorough biographical details which are not collected together in one place elsewhere, as they are here in our magazines.
