

Subject Index to NWPPA Magazines

1977 to Summer 1998

Key: S = Spring issue; A = Autumn; W = Winter; Chr = Christmas. (Terminology varied.)

Sometimes issues were combined, e.g. Spring/Summer (S/S) and Autumn/Christmas (A/Chr).

Before Winter 1977 the magazine usually consisted of a few pages stapled together, without substantial articles, so those issues are not indexed. Page numbers refer to the page at which the article or feature starts. Prior to Autumn 1980 pages were not numbered. Regular topical items such as dates and reports of the Association's meetings are not recorded in this index as there are so many of them. A separate list of meetings is available.

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
